

Kenilworth CC - Cricket Coaching 2017 season (Reception to Year 8)

2017 Season Outdoor Group Coaching Reception to Year 8

Fee for participation in 2017 Season outdoor group coaching: **£50 in total**

All outdoor group cricket coaching is at Kenilworth Cricket Club, Warwick Road, Kenilworth, CV8 1FE.

Coaching will be cancelled in inclement weather. There are no refunds for either cancelled or missed sessions. Where possible you will be informed by e-mail to the e-mail address you provide at registration if the session is cancelled for weather reasons.

Tuesday evening coaching times are as follows:

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2: 4.45pm - 5.45pm

Years 3, 4 and 5: 5.55pm - 6.55pm

Years 6, 7 and 8: 7.05pm - 8.15pm

The first coaching session will be on **Tuesday 25th April 2017** and the last coaching session will be held on **Tuesday 25th July 2017**.

No coaching will take place in the summer half term week (**Tuesday 30th May 2017**).

Registration

Places are limited. Once groups are full it will not be possible for your son/daughter to attend. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. A note will be posted on the club website once groups in any particular age group are full. Acknowledgements of registration forms will only be sent out by e-mail and on a weekly basis (not upon receipt).

To attend the 2017 season outdoor group coaching on a Tuesday your son/daughter must be in Reception to Year 8 and then:

Post the completed registration form and cheque for £50 made **payable to Kenilworth Cricket Club** to 1 Lilacvale Way, Cannon Hill, Coventry, CV4 7EL. It will not be possible for unregistered children to just turn up to attend the first session as that session may well already be full. Please do not send mail to the club's address or write Kenilworth Cricket Club on any envelope being sent through the post. Please do not pay by cash.

KCC reserve the right to ask your child to cease attending coaching sessions at any time in the event he/she is disrupting the coaching session.

What your child should wear

Whites are not required. Tracksuit/shorts with sporty top/jumper are fine. Trainers or cricket shoes should be worn. Please do ensure your child will be warm enough given the anticipated weather for the session.

Equipment

If your child is in Reception to Year 4: Please do not bring any equipment to the coaching session. The children use plastic cricket bats of varying sizes for speed and safety. Children will not be able to use their own equipment as it slows the session down. Spikes must not be worn.

If your child is in Years 5 to 8: These older age groups are likely to play with a cricket ball during the coaching session. Therefore please make sure your child has their own cricket box and has it in

their possession every Tuesday. All other equipment can be provided. However, if your child has other protective equipment, bat etc please do ensure they bring that equipment to the coaching session as well.

Parental “warm ups”

Adults and siblings must not play in the nets or on the outfield whilst the younger children are being coached. It is both distracting to the group being coached and dangerous for the younger children. When arriving for their coaching session the children should wait until their coach indicates the session is to commence before going on to the outfield. The only person who may introduce a cricket ball to the field of play on a Tuesday evening is the relevant age group’s coach.

Parking

If possible please walk to sessions at Kenilworth CC as parking is limited. If you need to drive, please drive carefully and very slowly when turning into the ground. Do not park against the far wall in the car park or you will be blocked in. You may park on the grass if the ground is dry.

Friends

Friends may not accompany your child to a coaching session unless they themselves are registered. If they wish to register please simply pass these details on to them.

Games

All games are 8-a-side. Those selected to participate in games will be notified at the relevant time. Should you receive a message asking for your child’s availability to play and you do not reply within 24 hours it will be presumed your child is unavailable and another child will be asked to play instead. Due to the numbers attending our coaching not all children in a particular age group can be selected to play in their age group’s games.

We intend to enter:

- U9 windball competitions for our Year 3 and 4 children (Cotswold Hills League and Warwickshire league) N.B. We will not be entering the U9 Hardball League in the 2017 season.
- U10 Warwickshire 8-a-side League (hardball) and U11 Cotswold Hills 8-a-side League (hardball) for our Year 5 children.
- U11 Warwickshire 8-a-side fixed date Monday Evening League (hardball) for our Year 6 children provided there is sufficient interest from our Year 6 children.
- U12 Warwickshire 8-a-side League.
- U13 Warwickshire 8-a-side League.

Friendly fixtures will also be arranged where possible. Children attending games who wish to practice either before, during (whilst waiting to bat), or after, must utilise the nets (wearing appropriate protective clothing) and must not warm up on the outfield.

Use of Nets

Registered junior attendees are welcome to use Kenilworth CC’s nets other than on Tuesday evenings provided there is an adult supervising and that use does not disrupt an ongoing game or training session. If a cricket ball is being used the batsman must wear full protective equipment. The adult must also check the nets are fit for use before the children commence playing.
